Home for the aged, orphans and the disabled

Our Objective:

Emulating Lord Buddha's benevolence and compassion, MBA Long Hua Home JB ("LHH") cares for the aged, orphans and the disabled, irrespective of race and religion.

Criteria for Admission to LHH:

- 1. Above 60 years old.
- 2. The less fortunate elders who do not have any relative to take care of them.
- 3. Aged but are able to cope with their daily activities of life.
- 4. All applicants shall not be addicted to drugs or suffering from infectious diseases. All applicants shall also undergo a medical check-up.
- 5. Every application for admission shall be signed by a guarantor and an introducer and is to be approved by LHH's Committee.
- 6. All inmates shall observe LHH's rules and regulations and the instructions of its persons-in-charge.
- LHH's Committee shall be empowered to reject any application or to accept any eligible applicant or to dismiss any inmate from LHH.

Locations:

- 1. Kg. Perpaduan, Batu 7 1/2, Jalan Skudai, Johor
 - This location has more than 50 inmates who are mainly old folks. Most of the inmates here are physically self-reliance.
- 2. 47-G Jalan Kebun Teh, 80250 Johor Bahru
 - Housed in a 3-storeyed building, this location has more than 150 inmates who are mainly orphans and the disabled.

Brief Introduction of LHH

LHH was founded by the late Ven. Shi Long Hua (Ven.). LHH accepts the aged, orphans and the disabled - free of charge !

In retrospect, "Guan Yin Cultivation Old Folks Home" was first set up in 1989 by Ven. in Kg. Perpaduan situated at Batu 7?, Jalan Skudai, Johor. In 1993, it expanded by setting up a centre for orphans and the disabled at Kebun Teh Road, Johor Bahru. The name of the Home was then changed

to LHH.

Ven. was truly a benevolent and compassionate monk whose spirit is likened to a bright light that radiates and shines in the darkness. Thus, Ven. has been much respected by all quarters of the community.

Ven. passed away peacefully on 5 July 1998, ie 12th day of the 5th lunar moon. LHH then came under the aegis of MBA. This entails a heavy responsibility on the part of MBA in taking care of over 200 innates. LHH's current Superintendent and Head of General Affairs were Ven. Miao Sheng and Ven. Chan Liang respectively. Ven Miao Khai and Ven. Jit Heng were the Treasurer and Head of Administration respectively. Ven Chek Huang also shoulders the responsibility for the construction of LHH's new building. In spite of the constraints ahead, the Sanghas at LHH are devoted to run LHH with much competency.

The 2 locations of LHH house a population of more than 200 inmates. Many of them are suffering from illnesses such as down's syndrome, breathing difficulty, asthma, twitch, back ache, polio, rheumatism, joint dislocation, skin diseases, long term illnesses or are not able to cope with their daily activities of life.
