- 6. Explain the Four Noble Truths as taught by the Buddha and show how the understanding of these Truths will free us from suffering.

- 8. What are the special qualities and virtues of Venerable Sariputta? How did Venerable Sariputta become the Chief Disciple of the Buddha?
